SVCA expects all students to love above reproach, demonstrating respect for God, country, family, faculty, staff, administration and fellow students. Students must therefore conduct themselves at all times in a manner in accordance with the teachings of scripture and must live a lifestyle commendable to Christ. Shenandoah Valley Christian Academy expects the parents of the children that attend our school to carefully guide, as well as monitor, the life activities of their children. If a child would become involved with drugs, smoking, homosexual lifestyle, gambling, or drinking alcoholic beverages, a parent is expected to stop such activity.

Regular church attendance needs to be encouraged by both the parent and the school staff. The family and the church should both have the goal of teaching honesty, morality, courtesy, kindness, orderly behavior, and a respectful demeanor toward authority. When a student's or parent's life becomes a detriment to these principles, Shenandoah Valley Christian Academy reserves the right to ask for the student(s) to be withdrawn or expelled from the institution.

If a dispute arises out of or relates to any of the services being provided by Shenandoah Valley Christian Academy, or any of its faculty or staff members, and if the dispute cannot be settled through direct discussion, then the parties agree to endeavor to settle the dispute in an amicable manner by submitting the dispute to one or more individuals who will attempt to resolve the dispute through Christian conciliation. If Christian conciliation is unsuccessful, then the parties agree to submit the unresolved controversy or claim arising out of or relating to the services being provided by Shenandoah Valley Christian Academy, or any of its faculty or staff members, to mediation under the Commercial Mediation Rules of the American Arbitration Association before resorting to arbitration. Thereafter, any unresolved controversy or claim arising out of or relating to the services being provided by Shenandoah Valley Christian Academy, or any of its faculty or staff members, may be settled by arbitration in accordance with the Commercial Arbitration Rules of the American Arbitration Association.

I have read and understand the standards of conduct prescribed in the SVCA handbook, and agree that my child will abide by them both at and away from school functions. I agree to fully support the school in its enforcement of the standards of conduct. As I am a Christian and SVCA is a Christian ministry organization, I agree not to make demands, threaten to sue, make any kind of accusation or complaint, or actually litigate any matter whatsoever relating to or resulting from the enforcement of the standards of conduct.
